DALLAS AREA RAPID TRANSIT (DART) LIGHT RAIL

Daily 4 - 12 a.m. | \$2.50 2-hour pass/\$5 day pass

DART is the longest light rail system in the country with over 90 miles of rail lines.

DART connects you to most of Dallas' entertainment districts, Kay Bailey Hutchison Convention Center Dallas, American Airlines Center, DFW International and Love Field airports, as well as Trinity Railway Express (TRE).
