

GETTING TO DALLAS

With two major airports providing daily direct flights into Dallas from over 170 destinations, Dallas is under 3 hours by air from almost anywhere in the country. Plus, the robust number of non-stop flights originating in Dallas offers travelers options and convenience.



DALLAS/FORT WORTH INTERNATIONAL (DFW) AIRPORT

FAST FACTS

- Twenty miles to Downtown Dallas
- Non-stop services to 165 domestic and 58 international destinations
- 1,800 flights a day
- 66 million passengers each year
- 60+ dining options including local DFW favorites like Gas Monkey Grill, Cool River Café, Dallas Cowboys Club and Twisted Root Burger
- Three airport hotels
- Minute Suites Nap Center features ten spacious private suites and hot showers

DEVELOPMENT

DFW Airport is currently upgrading its four original terminals with a \$2.7 billion Terminal Renewal and Improvement Program (TRIP) and is expected to be completed in 2017

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION | DALLAS AREA RAPID TRANSIT (DART)

- Light rail to Downtown Dallas: approximately one hour
- Cost: \$2.50/two-hour pass, \$5.00/day pass
- Operating 4 - 1am, 7 days/week

GROUND TRANSPORTATION

- Approximate taxi cost to Downtown Dallas: \$40
- Approximate shuttle cost to Downtown Dallas: \$19 per person

FAST FACTS

- Seven miles to Downtown Dallas
- Over 50 non-stop destinations
- 600 flights a day
- 15 million passengers each year
- 20 dining options including Sky Canyon by Celebrity Chef Stephan Pyles
- Love Field Conference Center located at the airport

DEVELOPMENT

In 2014 the airport underwent a \$519 million renovation, which opened 20 new gates, expanded the main lobby and baggage claim areas, opened a new ticketing/check-in hall and doubled the number of airport concessionaires

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION | DALLAS AREA RAPID TRANSIT (DART)

- DART's Love Link 524 operates between Dallas Love Field and Inwood/Love Field Station, providing an airport connection to the DART Rail Green Line and Orange Line.
- Light rail to Downtown Dallas: approximately 30-50 minutes
- Cost: \$2.50/two-hour pass, \$5.00/day pass
- Operating 4 - 1am, 7 days/week

GROUND TRANSPORTATION

- Approximate taxi cost to Downtown Dallas: \$18
- Approximate shuttle cost to Downtown Dallas: \$19 per person
